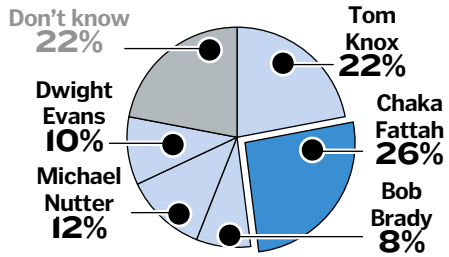




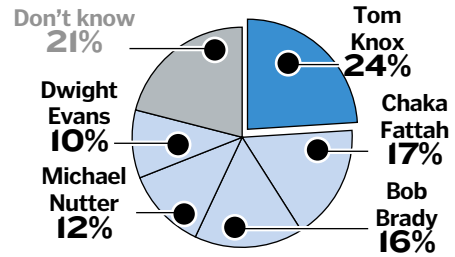
KNOX TAKES THE LEAD

The latest *Daily News* Keystone Poll on the mayor's race shows that millionaire Tom Knox's TV ads have paid off. He has overtaken Chaka Fattah, the front-runner since the first poll last summer. The latest poll also shows a surge by Bob Brady, who has doubled his total from January. Unlike Knox and Brady, Fattah has yet to air TV ads. The election is May 15.

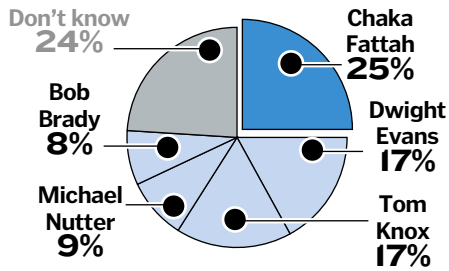

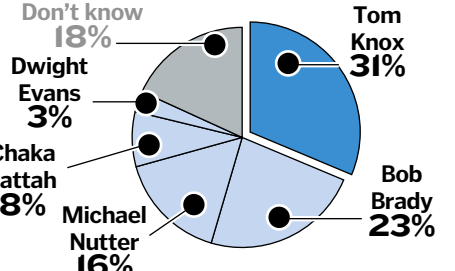


Q: If the Democratic primary election for mayor were being held today, for whom would you vote?

AFRICAN-AMERICAN VOTERS



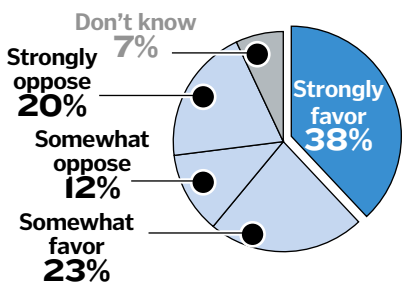
WHITE VOTERS



Fattah still enjoys a lead among African-American voters, while Knox leads among whites. (Same question as above)

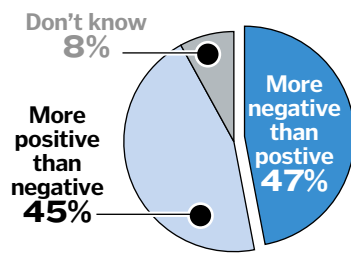
The poll also showed Philadelphians are ready for strong crime-fighting tools, such as police frisking suspicious persons in public places.

METHODOLOGY: The *Daily News*/Keystone Poll was conducted by Franklin & Marshall College's Center for Opinion Research, which surveyed 364 registered Democrats in Philadelphia March 28-April 3. The margin of error is plus or minus 5.1 percent. Totals may add up to 99 or 101 due to rounding.
